

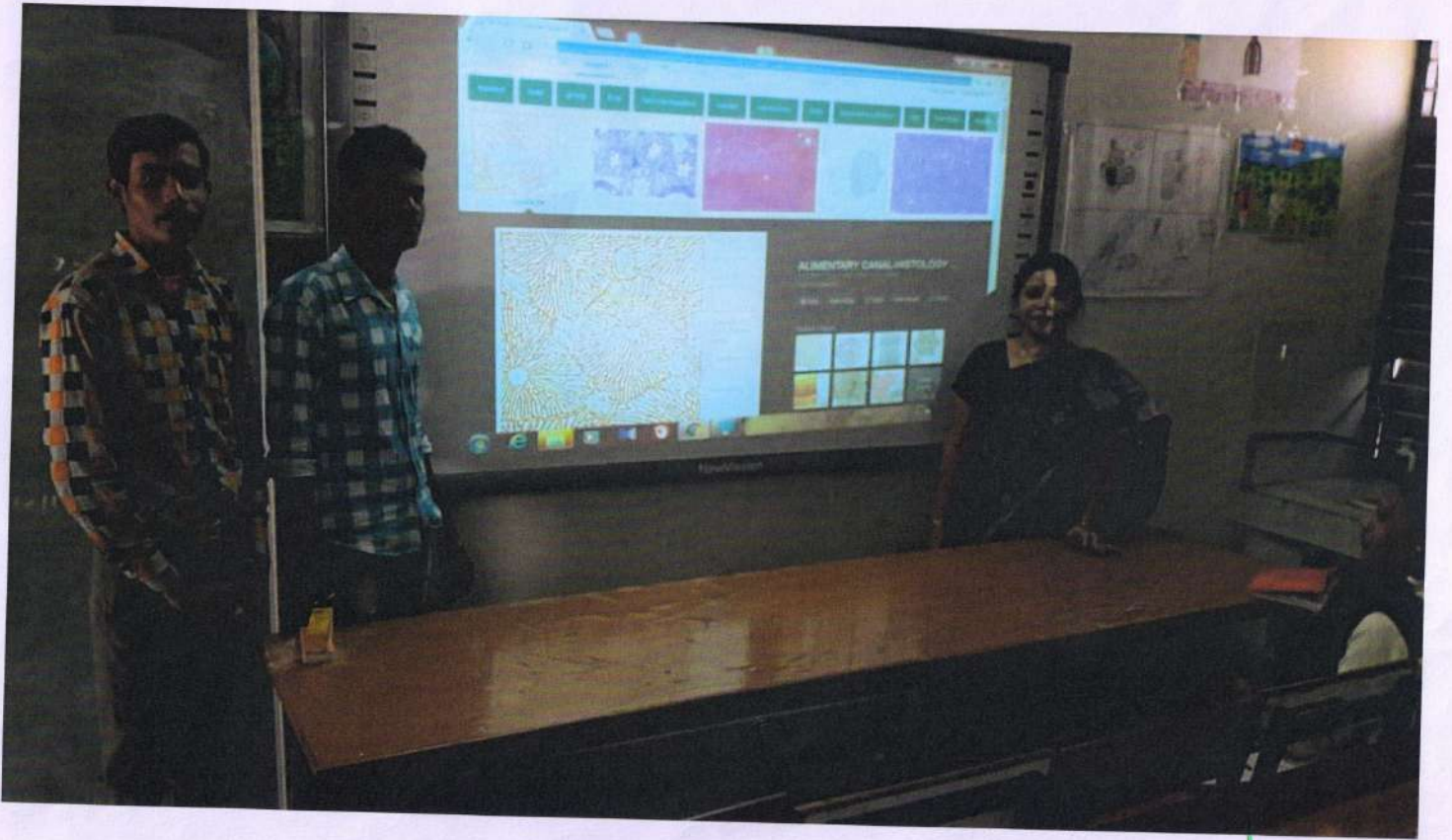

# **Listen, learn and speak English - Prof Ghanshyam 'World' is more significant than word-Acharya Dr.Sharma**

## **A Joint workshop was organised on 'Communication skill' Utai**

Utai/"The world would be dark if there is no light of 'word'. There cannot be existence of world without 'word'. 'Word' is more significant than 'world'. It started from 'letter to word', 'word to sentence' and with conversation the entire world came into existence. From This point only communication started. Beginning from VedasShastras, Ramayan, Mahabharat, the importance of word is very effective tradition. By using minimum words providing maximum information is the art of communication skill Tulsidasji, Kabir, and Bihari are the best example of it. Speakers facial expressions also play very greater role in communication. for today's youth communication in English helps in preparing for interview". These views are expressed by language scholar and principal, Dr Maheshchandra Sharma in a workshop on 'Communication Skill', organised by Govt. D. T. P.G. College Utai and Dau Uttam Sao Govt. College Machandur. Spoken English Communication skill expert, and Head of the department of English from Dau Uttam Sao Govt. College Machandur interacted with the students in a very emphatic style with the help of PPT and video. He said four basic skill to learn a language are listening, speaking, reading and writing. Our ears are the uploading units, brain is the largest harddisk available in the world and mouth, the downloading unit. The students have a great deal of fear to speak and learn english and they don't even try to speak english and they lack confidence and determination. Students should use sentences and phrases rather single words when they speak. This would be the first step to learn English. In second step students should not be worried about grammar rules and speak fearlessly. He also emphatically urged the students to concentrate on listening which happens to be the first phase of learning English. With the help of videos he made students understand the fact that any language especially English could be learned only by 'ears' and not by 'eyes'. The methodology of the workshop was so interesting that it touched the minds and heart of the students. Some of them for the first time ever in life gave their feedback in english and promised themselves that now onwards they will speak in English. Dr. A. A. Khan HOD of English narrated the use of communication in our lives and advised the students to use various nuances related to the use of English as a means of communication. Dr. P. Vasanta Kala co-ordinator of IQAC and a member of English department while conducting the program highlighted on the objectives of organizing the workshop. This program was organised by IQAC. Observing the inclination of Students in this workshop, the college management has decided to organise more such workshops. College always apart from enhancing the quality of education is also dedicated to cultural social responsibility.
